ESB's Chief Executive Padraig McManus inaugurated this new Corporate Social Responsibility project, ESB ELECTRIC AID IRELAND. The initiative continues ESB's proactive approach to assisting the needy, the underprivileged and those with disabilities.

In refocusing ESB's traditional approach to funding, ESB ELECTRIC AID IRELAND aims to make a real impact on a small number of specific causes.

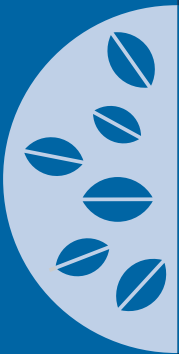
This new funding initiative partners ElectricAid, the social justice fund of ESB staff and pensioners which was set up in 1987 to contribute to the relief of poverty and emergencies at home and abroad.

This partnership means that ElectricAid, supported by matching ESB funding, will now mainly focus attention on long-term sustainable improvement in disadvantaged communities overseas, while ESB ELECTRIC AID IRELAND will devote specific funding to address targeted areas of disadvantage and need on the island of Ireland.

ESB staff were invited to select two areas of need from the many worthy causes that abound in Irish society.

The following were chosen to be supported by the new fund for the first three years of the project:

- **Care of the homeless**
- **Suicide prevention and counselling**



GUIDELINES

Grants will be allocated on a quarterly basis. While it is expected that most grants will be of the order of €10,000, some larger grants will also be available.

The following groups will be supported:

- Registered charities
- Not for profit organisations
- Community & voluntary groups

Projects must be located within the Republic of Ireland or Northern Ireland and must fall under either or both the following areas:

1. Care of the homeless
2. Suicide prevention & counselling

The application must have the full support of your organisation and any other support or partnership organisations involved.

Successful applicants will be required to submit progress and completion reports as appropriate, supported by receipts and other relevant documentation. Projects will be subject to monitoring during the course of implementation.

In some cases further information may be requested and applicants may be required to meet a representative of **ESB ELECTRIC AID IRELAND to discuss details of the project.**

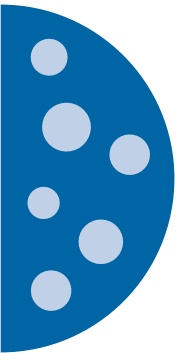
Funding must be used exclusively for the purpose of implementing the project as stated in the application form. Confirmation may be required from the organisation's auditors that funds have been used for the purpose for which they were granted.

A copy of a valid bank statement may be required to support your application.

Material included with the application form and subsequent communications will not be returned.

Note: All information supplied will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

Applicants may be asked to participate in publicity relating to the promotion of ESB.

- High risk ventures.

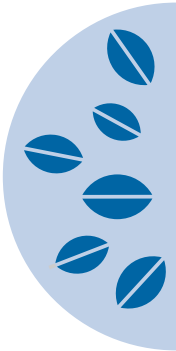
